Purpose of the Initiative

The USSW Area Presidency launched the Latino and non-English Speaking Communities Initiative to better support non-English-speaking members, especially Spanish speakers. Goals include:

- Language-specific sacrament meetings and translations.
- English learning support.
- Leadership development.
- Increased participation in church activities, temple ordinances, and missionary preparation.

Role of Senior Service Missionary Couples

- Bilingual married couples are called to help implement this initiative.
- Responsibilities include training leaders, promoting participation, mentoring, and improving English skills.
- Such Senior Missionary Couples will serve at either the Stake or Coordinating Council level.

Training and Support

Two Area Senior Missionary Couples (“Area Training Couples”) lead training, implementation and support:

These Area Senior Missionary Couples train and assist the nominated stake or council missionary couples based on their specific Coordinating Council assignments.

Recommendation Process

1. **Identify Candidate Couples:** Stake President and Area Seventy must first recommend the couple to the Burrolas or Davidsons, including the Stake or Coordinating Council(s) they will support.
2. **Initial Interview:** The Area Training Couples will interview the candidates to confirm the candidates’ understanding what the calling will entail and the availability and readiness of the candidates.
3. **Missionary Recommendation Instructions:** Instructions will be provided by the Area Training Couples to begin the process of a missionary recommendation.
