Approval of Stake President of Early Assignment End without Ending Mission

There are two types of early release requests:

EARLY END OF ASSIGNMENT WITHOUT ENDING MISSION IMMEDIATELY (THIS MEMO)

In this scenario, the missionary's current assignment is to be shortened, but the mission is not to be ended until a future date.

- Using Google Chrome, log into SMMS (https://servicemissionary.churchofjesuschrist.org/) and log in.
- In the Action Items section, click on "Modification Requests Due".
- Scroll down to the name of missionary in the list and click on "Assignment ID" to left of the missionary's name.
- If the Proposed End Date is acceptable, click on the "Approve Request" button.
- If the Proposed End Date is also to be the end of the mission, on the left-hand side of the screen, click the "Edit" link next to "Service Assignment End Date" (which is the mission end date) and change the date to match the Proposed End Date. Unless and until you are sure about the mission end date, do not change the Service Assignment End Date.

IMMEDIATE EARLY RELEASE (ANOTHER MEMO)

The other type of early release is for an immediate release, resulting in an early release from the missionary's current assignment and the end of the mission. Instructions for this type of release are in a separate memo.
